



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT PAYMENTS

Where do I mail my payments?

Payments for Blitz and Boom can be mailed to: **BMS Blitz, PO Box 1833, Brandon MS 39043.**

Payments for Brio and Bellas can be mailed to: **Brandon Brio, PO Box 214, Brandon MS 39043.**

Who I do I make checks payable to?

Checks should be payable to **Blitz, Brio or Brandon Show Choir Association.** We keep separate accounts for the middle school and high school, so separate checks should be written if you have children in both middle school and high school show choirs. **PLEASE** do not make show choir payments in the school's front office. We are a separate entity from the school and cannot credit your account for funds that we didn't receive.

Can I bring payments to school?

Yes. Payments may be brought to class or practice and then forwarded by the directors to the treasurers. However, keep in mind that the directors are busy teaching and managing practices, so it might take a few days to a week for them to get your check to the treasurer and for you to see the funds credited in Charms. If you plan to pay in cash, please either give that directly to the treasurer or purchase a money order (usually free at your bank). We do not want your cash sitting in the classroom where it can be lost or stolen, and the directors do not issue receipts.

What is the "Miscellaneous" section of my Charms account?

Miscellaneous is where funds are posted if there is not quite enough deposited into your account to pay a whole month's dues payment. For example, mom sends half a payment each month, and dad sends half a payment. Or maybe you overpaid one of your fixed payments by \$10. We also post some of the fundraiser profits there. When there is enough in miscellaneous to make an entire payment, the misc. funds can be transferred to one or more of your monthly fixed payments. If you want to use a misc. credit towards a payment, you would simply pay the difference in your payment and what you have in misc. For example you have \$65 in misc. and owe a \$265 payment, so you would send a check for \$200. Your new misc. balance of \$265 would be enough for the next fixed payment that you owe. Credits in misc. can also be applied toward family trip balances, but dues take priority over family travel.
